The Education Act. The provisions governing special education in Ontario were introduced into the Education Act by the Education Amendment Act, 1980, more commonly known as Bill 82. Since that time, some of the original provisions contained in Bill 82 were removed or amended to reflect language and program evolution, based on research, changing practices and policy environments.

Each of the student teachers was assigned to work full day in the classroom to gradually assume all non-teaching and teaching responsibilities.
